

Delegates

The RI APTA elects delegates to represent the chapter each June in the House of Delegates, the governing body of the APTA.

Qualifications- only active members may serve as Chapter delegates. The number of delegates is determined by the size of Chapter membership, in compliance with APTA Bylaws.

Duties- Participation in delegation meetings and representing the Chapter in the HoD. There are delegation meetings each year, and these may be held monthly in preparation for the HoD meeting. RI APTA is also part of the Northeast Caucus which meets two times per year. The delegation also hosts a caucus meeting for the Chapter's membership. The House of Delegates meeting is held annually in June at locations determined by the APTA. The RI APTA provides some assistance, but not full reimbursement, for travel and housing associated with participation in the HoD.
